Note: Last names are sufficient answers unless the question specifies that a first name is required. Also, this is a test of knowledge NOT spelling. Phonetically correct answers are fine.



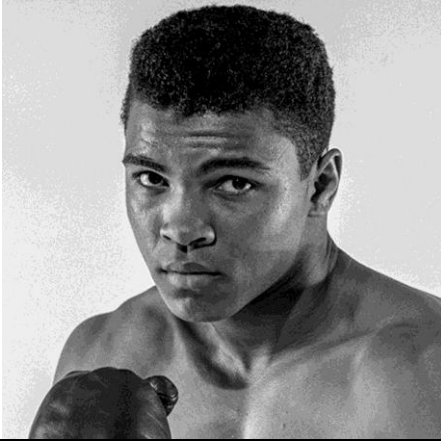
